- O Forms W-2 (Wages)
- O 1099-INT (Interest Income)
- O **1099-DIV** (Dividend Income)
- 0 1099-B and 1099-S (Sale of Stocks, Securities, Crypto and other Investment Property)
- O **1099-G** (Unemployment Compensation)
- 0 1099-K (Payment from apps, such as Venmo or Cashapp, in excess of \$600)
- 1099-R (Retirement Income Pension, IRA, and Annuity Distributions)
- O 1099-S (Sale of real estate)
- O 1099-MISC (Miscellaneous Income)
- O SSA-1099 (Social Security Benefit Statement)
- 0 1099-SA (Distribution from a Health Savings Account (HSA) or Medical Savings Account (MSA))
- 0 1099-A and 1099-C (Foreclosures, Short Sales, or Cancellation of Debt)
- O Forms K-1 (Partnerships, Trusts, S-Corporations)
- O Forms W-2G (Gambling Income)
- O Brokerage Statements: Including the Statement of Realized Gains & Losses for sales in 2024

### **Expenses**

- O Form 1098-T (College Tuition Statement for you or dependents)

## **Itemized Deductions**

- Medical Expenses (if significant) and any Health Insurance / Long-Term Care Insurance Premiums paid
- O Form 1095-A (Qualified Health Insurance purchased through an exchange)
- O **Property Tax Statements** (Real Estate Taxes paid in 2024 and 2025 if available)
- O **Settlement Statements** for a home sale, refinance, or 2<sup>nd</sup> mortgage
- O Vehicle License Tab payments
- O Form 1098 (Mortgage Interest Statement)
- Charitable Contribution Receipts (receipt for every contribution, regardless of amount)
- O **Description of Non-Cash Contributions** for each gift when the total for the year is greater than \$500
- **O** Investment Interest Expense
- O Gambling Expenses to the extent of Gambling Income

#### Miscellaneous

- O Childcare Expenses and provider information
- O Tax Notices received from the IRS or other taxing authority
- Adoption Expenses
- O **Alimony** paid or received under a pre-2019 agreement
- O **Rental Property / Business** Income and Expenses
- O Contributions to a 529 Savings Plan (Account Number, Brokerage Company, Amount)
- O Closing Disclosure Documents for any Real Estate transactions
- O Foreign Banking or Investment Account
- **O Identity Verification Pin From the IRS If Applicable**
- O **Any other items** that may have a possible tax impact
